If you wish to seek care outside of Kelsey-Seybold, you will need to obtain your medical record by calling the Medical Records Department at 713-442-5700 and filling out a Release of Healthcare Information Form.

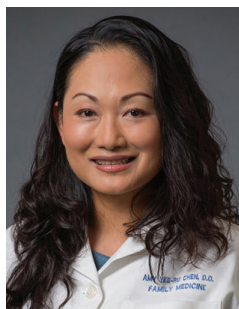
Family Medicine Physicians Welcoming New Patients at Downtown Clinic
