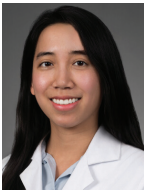
Rheumatologists Welcoming New Patients

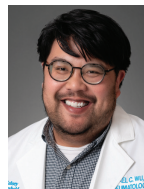
