

# Labor & Delivery Frequently Asked Questions

## How does the relocation affect my delivery?

- Your doctor will no longer be performing deliveries at The Woman's Hospital of Texas. They will now be performing all deliveries at Memorial Hermann Memorial City. The Labor & Delivery department is located on the third floor of the same building as the Kelsey-Seybold Memorial City Clinic.

## If I am due within one week before or after my doctor relocates, should I register at both The Woman's Hospital of Texas and Memorial Hermann Memorial City?

- Yes, we recommend registering at both hospitals to help ensure a smoother admission process when you arrive for delivery.

## What if I go into labor prior to March 6?

- Regardless of the hospital where you registered, **you would deliver at The Woman's Hospital of Texas** with your Kelsey-Seybold OB/GYN doctor and team.

## What if I go into labor on March 6 or later?

- Regardless of the hospital where you registered, **you would deliver at Memorial Hermann Memorial City** with your Kelsey-Seybold OB/GYN doctor and team.

## Why do I need to register at the hospital prior to my delivery?

- Registering at the hospital prior to your delivery is recommended, but not required. The pre-registration process will help make check-in go smoother when you arrive at the hospital. Pre-registering can also help you know what to expect financially for your delivery.

## Can I still deliver with my Kelsey-Seybold OB/GYN at The Woman's Hospital of Texas if I prefer that location?

- Unfortunately, your doctor will no longer perform deliveries at The Woman's Hospital of Texas as of March 6. Memorial Hermann Memorial City has an exceptional, family-centered Labor & Delivery environment and provides comfortable and private rooms for families. Their top priority is the safety and wellbeing of mom and baby, and they have put numerous mechanisms in place to ensure patients receive the very best care.

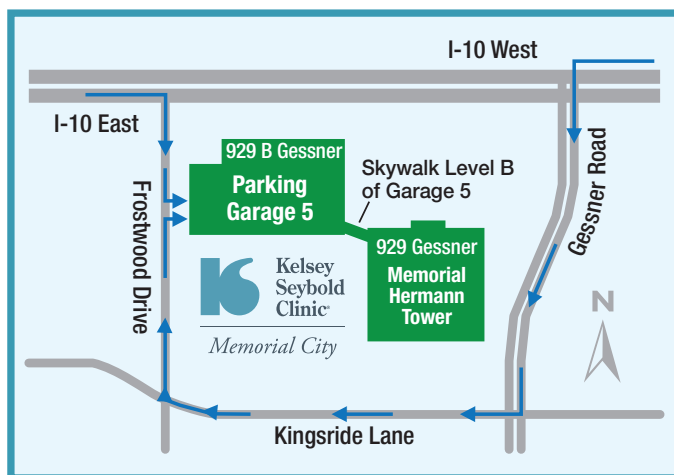
We strongly suggest patients review the parking information below in advance of your appointment at Memorial City Clinic. Parking is complimentary and located in the attached Garage 5. We recommend patients allow an additional 10 – 15 minutes for parking to help ensure you arrive on time for your scheduled appointment.

## From I-10 heading east from Katy to Downtown

1. Take the Gessner Road exit and stay in the far-right lane of the frontage road.
2. Before Gessner Road, turn right on Frostwood Drive.
3. Turn left into Parking Garage 5. Parking is free.
4. Take the Skywalk on Level B to the Memorial Hermann Tower at 929 Gessner and take the elevator or escalator down to the lobby.
5. At the far end of the lobby, take the elevator up to the 14th floor.  
**Kelsey-Seybold Clinic – Memorial City** is in Suite 1450.

## From I-10 heading west from Downtown to Katy

1. Take the Gessner Road exit and turn left onto Gessner Road.
2. Turn right on Kingsride Lane.
3. Turn right on Frostwood Drive.
4. Turn right into Parking Garage 5. Parking is free.
5. Take the Skywalk on Level B to the Memorial Hermann Tower at 929 Gessner and take the elevator or escalator down to the lobby.
6. At the far end of the lobby, take the elevator up to the 14th floor.
