- O Nonskid socks and/or slippers
- O Maternity underwear
- O Nursing bra
- O Nursing pads and nipple cream
- O Breastfeeding pillow
- O Breast pump + hands-free bra
- O Change of clothes and comfortable shoes to wear home
- O Toiletries
- O Hair brush and hair ties
- O Lip moisturizer
- O Massage oils or lotions
- O Breath mints and snacks
- O Relaxation materials: books, magazines, music

- O Eyeglasses or contact lenses, if applicable
- O Cell phone and charger

## For Spouse/Coach/Partner

- O Watch or smartphone with app to time contractions
- O Camera/video camera and charged or with extra batteries
